a HISTORIC CAMPAIGN

The goal of raising \$125 million, announced not long after the 125th anniversary of the founding of the University of La Verne, was the most ambitious fundraising goal in the history of this institution. *Create the Future: The Campaign for the University of La Verne* set a new path forward for the university, prioritizing student scholarships, faculty development, capital projects, and technological enhancements. The campaign reaffirmed and built upon the university’s mission to provide an enriching and relevant educational experience that prepares our diverse population of traditional-age, adult, and graduate learners to achieve *more than they ever imagined*.

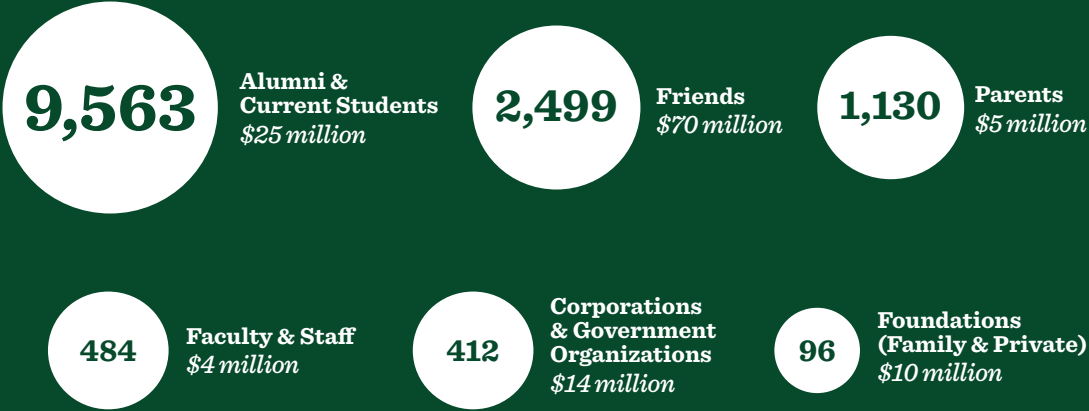

SCHOLARSHIPS: *our* MISSION

Generous scholarships are the bedrock of everything that we do at the University of La Verne. They make our quality education accessible to all qualified students regardless of their financial status.

Give Something Back Partnership

Give Something Back Foundation offers \$1 million in scholarships to disadvantaged students who wish to attend the University of La Verne. Students may have experienced homelessness, the incarceration of a parent, foster care, or other significant challenges. At the University of La Verne, they find a welcoming environment and a team of faculty and staff who are committed to assisting them.

Heshmat Mirsepassi Scholarship

As an elementary school teacher in her native Iran, Heshmat Mirsepassi was moved by the plight of students who suffered from food insecurity. Upon her death, it was revealed that she had slowly amassed a small fortune that she dedicated to helping Muslim students in need. In 2019, Mirsepassi's husband established the Heshmat Mirsepassi Scholarship in her name. To date, the fund has awarded 26 scholarships to Muslim students.

Small, Great Things Scholarship for CAPA

University of La Verne's Campus Accelerated Program for Adults (CAPA) makes it easier for working adults and other non-traditional age students to receive a quality education. These students are often at a loss, however, when it comes to financial aid, the vast majority of which is designated for traditional undergraduate students. Enter university trustee Joseph Fengler '89 and his mother, Dee Giannamore, who raised him as a single mother while putting herself through college. Seeing a real financial need, they created the Small, Great Things Scholarship for CAPA specifically to help non-traditional adult learners in need. Today, it is the only scholarship solely dedicated to CAPA students—but Giannamore and Fengler hope to be the catalysts to change that.

Sara and Michael Abraham Center for Veteran Student Success

Thanks to a transformative donation from Sara and Michael Abraham, the Center for Veteran Student Success underwent a major renovation and renaming in order to better serve our veteran students, providing a friendly place for them to gather, socialize, and access campus services and resources. “This is your place to spend quality time with other classmates and veterans,” said Michael Abraham, an Army veteran who has served on our Board of Trustees for more than 20 years.



Ahmanson Veterans Scholarship Initiative

Major funding from the Ahmanson Foundation empowers the University of La Verne to recruit and retain veteran students who are eligible for the Post-9/11 GI Bill. The Ahmanson Veterans Scholarship is open to any graduate or undergraduate veteran student, regardless of major.

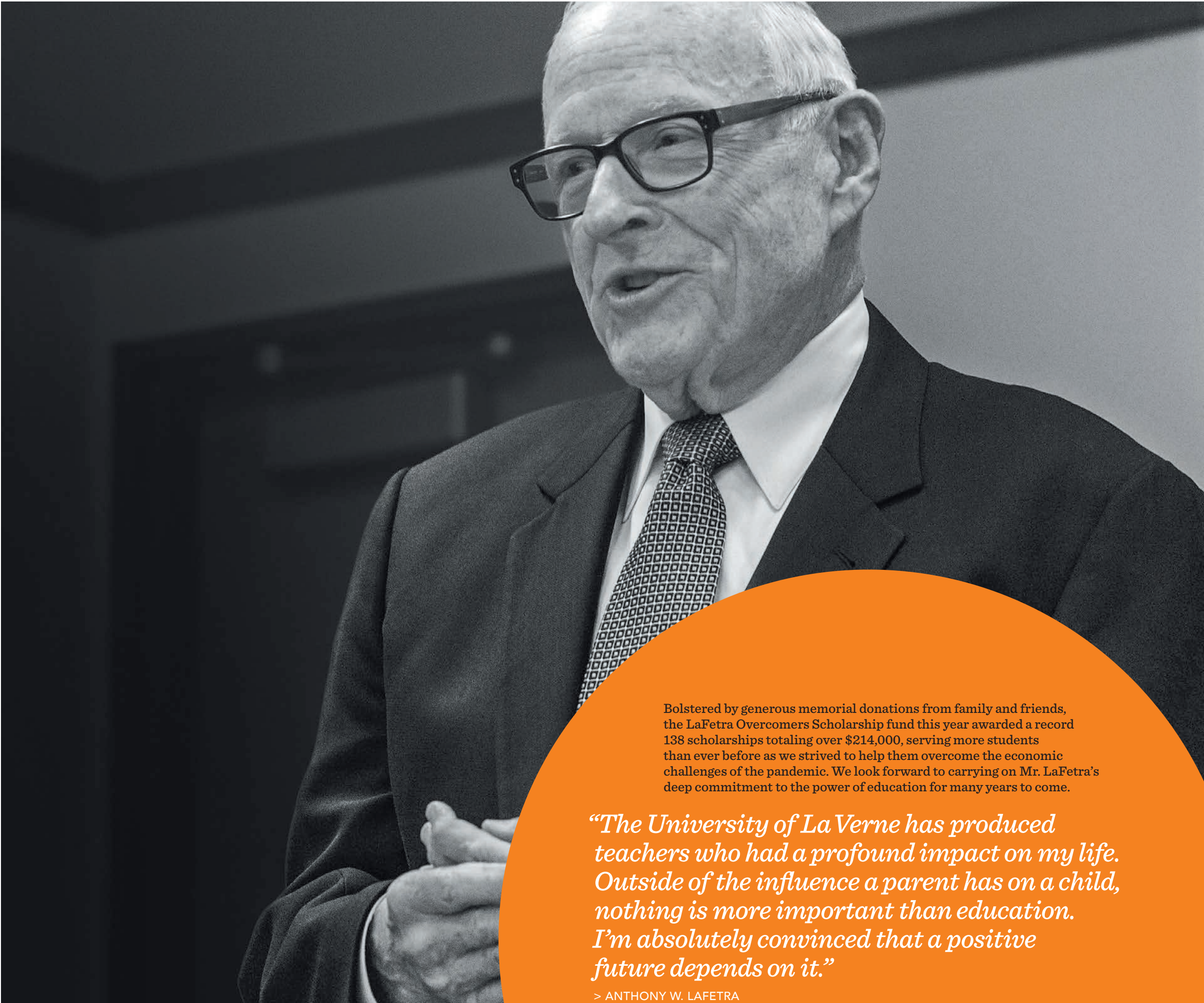


ANTHONY W. LAFETRA

1940–2021

The university community mourns the passing of Anthony W. LaFetra, longtime University of La Verne trustee and president and CEO of Rain Bird Corporation. LaFetra’s gift of \$10 million in 2016 is the largest cash gift of the comprehensive campaign, leading to our first-ever named college, the LaFetra College of Education (LFCE).

A passionate supporter of education, LaFetra also created the LaFetra Family Endowed Chair for Excellence in Teaching and Service as well as the LaFetra Overcomers Scholarship, and contributed toward the university’s development of a new college focused on health and community well-being.



Bolstered by generous memorial donations from family and friends, the LaFetra Overcomers Scholarship fund this year awarded a record 138 scholarships totaling over \$214,000, serving more students than ever before as we strived to help them overcome the economic challenges of the pandemic. We look forward to carrying on Mr. LaFetra’s deep commitment to the power of education for many years to come.

SPOTLIGHT:

The Center for Neurodiversity, Learning, *and* Wellness

Albert Einstein and Thomas Edison were both known to have dyslexia. When they were children, their parents were told that they were uneducable. Imagine if they had not persevered with their unique talents, which continue to inform our society today.

The term “neurodiversity” reflects a range of neurologically-based mood, learning, and behavior differences such as autism, ADHD, dyslexia, and schizophrenia. Many students are marginalized for what are perceived to be deficits and disorders, without being recognized and respected for the

innate genius, talents, strengths, and contributions they offer. Consequently, gross inequities in educational access, social inclusion, and long-term career opportunities exist within this student population.

With the support of Mr. LaFetra’s naming gift, the Center for Neurodiversity, Learning, and Wellness (CNLW) at the University of La Verne’s LaFetra College of Education was established in 2017 to increase public awareness of neurological differences and support neurodivergent students to thrive in learning and in life.

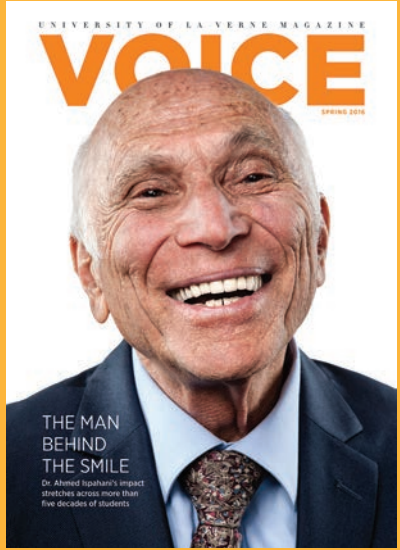
CNLW’s many accomplishments to date include:

- > Continuing LFCE’s renowned dyslexia clinic
- > Launching a new dyslexia teacher training program
- > Organizing four neurodiversity symposia
- > Hosting an expert speaker series on campus
- > Launching a professional certificate in neurodiversity and inclusion program in partnership with San Bernardino Unified School District
- > Conducting topical workshops for students and teachers
- > Offering ongoing coaching and mentorship for college students
- > Launching The Genius Project, a summer prep program for neurodivergent students transitioning from high school to college

Endowed chairs also strengthen the University of La Verne’s ability to recruit distinguished, world-class scholars to teach, conduct research, and publish and present their work throughout the world, invigorating the student experience.

Searing Family Endowed Chair in Honor of Dr. Ahmed Ispahani

In 2015, the Searing family—Board of Trustees Secretary and campaign co-chair Sue Searing ’71, her husband Lee ’70, and their children Christina, Richard ’06, and Katherine—established the Searing Family Endowed Chair in Honor of Dr. Ahmed Ispahani, one of the University of La Verne’s most beloved and sought-after professors. As a former student of Dr. Ispahani, Richard knew well what a wonderful teacher he was, enlivening every class with his intelligence, knowledge, caring, and easy rapport. Dr. Ispahani continues to inspire students with his deep commitment to the classroom, and the endowed chair will support high-quality teaching for many generations to come.

Fletcher Jones Endowed Chair in Computational Sciences (Biology)

Established in 2015 with major funding from Fletcher Jones Foundation, the Fletcher Jones Endowed Chair in Computational Sciences (Biology) empowered the university to hire noted scientist Dr. Tatiana Tatarinova, who was tasked with laying the foundation for a cutting-edge program in computational biology—a discipline that uses computers, mathematics, and algorithms to unlock long-held secrets of biological processes. Named one of the top 10 Russian female scientists by *Forbes*, the versatile Dr. Tatarinova has researched “agroinformatics,” a plant genome analysis that can eventually be used to assist farmers worldwide in growing higher-yield crops. She has also researched pharmacogenetics (determining appropriate drug dosages for the general population based on mathematical modeling) and the genetic origins of Ashkenazi Jews.

Citrus Roots Collection

University of La Verne is the proud recipient of a gift from Citrus Roots – Preserving Citrus Heritage Foundation that includes publications, photos, education, and artistic works to be housed in the university's art collection. As the City of La Verne was once known as “the heart of the Orange Empire,” our university is the ideal home for this important collection. The foundation's gift enables the university to bring the transformative history of Southern California's citrus industry alive for students and surrounding communities.

Nathan Chow Program of Film and Television

Thanks to a transformative gift from alumnus Nathan C. H. Chow, MS '01, DPA '11, chairman of the board at Shih Hsin University in Taipei, Taiwan, and managing director of China Metropolitan Ventures, the university is building a top tier film and television program by significantly upgrading its facilities and expanding its inventory of equipment. The new Nathan Chow Program of Film and Television will help to meet the unprecedented global demand for qualified film and television professionals, putting the University of La Verne on a par with top film and television programs across the country.

Terrence E. Deal Leadership Institute

Founded by renowned leadership expert, author, and international consultant Dr. Terry Deal '61, the Terrence E. Deal Leadership Institute at the University of La Verne explores leadership as it relates to a variety of approaches and professional fields. Using a salon discussion setting, guests of the institute engage in conversation and the pursuit of knowledge and fellowship around the topic of leadership.



GROWING to MEET *the* FUTURE

Founded to create a place where everyone belongs, the Ludwick Center for Spirituality, Cultural Understanding, and Community Engagement embodies the heart and core values of the University of La Verne.

Incorporating spaces for interfaith worship and dialogue, including Muslim prayer rooms, along with classrooms, study areas, quiet rooms, and offices for key campus services, the Ludwick Center is a holistic space where students, faculty, staff, and community members can congregate, practice their faiths, build relationships, engage in thoughtful reflection and productive dialogue, and gain skills for the ongoing work of equity and inclusion. The center was made possible by the support of many donors, but special thanks must go to lead donors and highly respected civic leaders Sarah Ludwick MS '94 and Art Ludwick.

RANDALL LEWIS CENTER *for* WELL-BEING *and* RESEARCH

The Randall Lewis Center for Well-Being and Research was established with a lead gift from prominent real estate executive and philanthropist Randall Lewis. Following its opening in fall 2019, the center quickly became a popular resource on the University of La Verne's main campus, welcoming thousands of students, faculty, and staff to its facility for classes, workshops, topical lectures, and peer support groups revolving around physical fitness, nutrition, cooking, mental and emotional health, and more. During quarantine, Lewis Center staff pivoted to offer robust online programming via the Zoom video conferencing platform.

The Lewis Center has been a big hit with our students. Much more than just a fitness center, its welcoming staff and well-designed patio and lounge spaces made it a second home to many during the pre-pandemic months, and its thoughtful online programming has continued to inspire student engagement.

Bauccio Endowed Executive Director

Thanks to a generous gift from Bon Appétit Management Company co-founder and well-being advocate Fedele Bauccio, the university was able to endow the Lewis Center's executive director position. Sarah Rodman-Alvarez, the first Bauccio Endowed Executive Director, is a public health expert with extensive experience researching and creating programming for health equity and food systems. Under her visionary leadership, the Lewis Center has launched such pioneering initiatives as faculty research fellowships and the Inclusive Well-Being Fellowships for students.

SUPPORT *in a* TIME *of* NEED

Student Emergency Fund



When COVID-19 caused the nation to shut down, we knew that our students would be among the populations most vulnerable to the pandemic’s devastating economic and public health threats. Before federal aid became available, University Advancement quickly pivoted to focus on raising funds for the rapid-response Student Emergency Fund so that students could meet their most pressing immediate needs. And unlike the federal funds that became available later, both international and DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals) students are eligible to apply for Student Emergency Fund grants.

Campaign Against Student Hunger

After hearing stories of students skipping meals to help make ends meet, campus leaders decided to launch the Campaign Against Student Hunger, also known as the Leo Food Pantry. Thanks to robust support from the community, this program now serves 80–100 students a month through food box distributions and a campus meal voucher program.

Bristol Haynes Leadership Endowed Scholarship

Taylor Bristol Warner and Crista Haynes both graduated from the University of La Verne College of Law in 2011. Highly engaged students, Warner was chief managing editor of the Law Review and founder of the Public Interest Law Foundation, while Haynes served as editor-in-chief of the Journal of Law, Business and Ethics. Both went on to establish successful individual practices. In 2014, they founded the Bristol Haynes Leadership Endowed Scholarship to help other students and inspire them to give back as well.

Performance Excellence and Innovation

University of La Verne will operate within a culture of excellence and innovation that focuses on quality, efficiency, and high-performance teams. We commit to financial sustainability, multiyear planning, and a culture of accountability.



COLLEGE *of* HEALTH and COMMUNITY WELL-BEING

The University of La Verne's critical transformative initiative is the establishment of a new College of Health and Community Well-Being (CHCWB).

The COVID-19 pandemic revealed the inherent social inequities of access to health care regionally and nationally as well as a critical shortage of qualified health care professionals across the board. Deeply tied to our mission and core values, the CHCWB's curricula will work toward building a more holistic and equitable approach to health care delivery by focusing on the social determinants of health, such as race, ethnicity, culture, and socioeconomic status—factors that have long impacted

patients' ability to access quality care and well-being. As a proud Hispanic Serving Institution, representing the rich diversity of Inland Southern California, the university is aptly poised to create future health care solutions and supply graduates to work at all levels of health care in the region, becoming a leader in inclusive and equitable approaches to preparing future leaders in health care and community well-being.

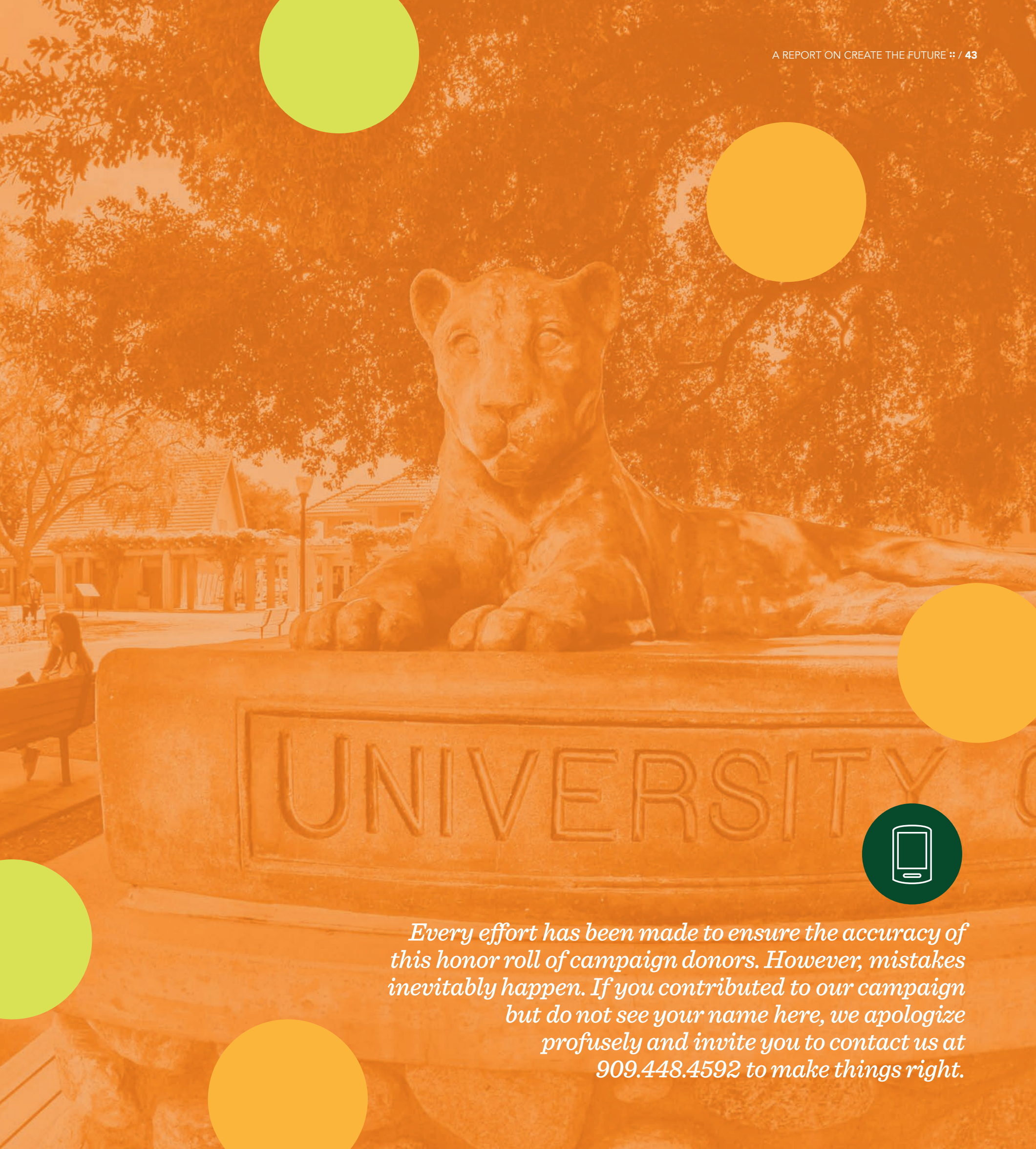
