## APPEAL FOR ACADEMIC REINSTATEMENT

Main campus undergraduates who are academically disqualified (AD) may appeal for academic reinstatement after the *first* AD. They may also appeal if it has been at least one year since their *second* AD. Please submit the appeal, with the supporting documents, to the Dean of Academic & Career Success at **least** three (3) weeks prior to the start of the upcoming academic term.

Important: Do not submit the appeal if the student (you, yours) has an accounting or collections hold since an	
approved academic reinstatement would not supersede your financial obligations prior to registering for classes.

☐ Student's written statement: brief 1-2 pages why you struggled and failed to meet normal	
academic standards and why you should be reinstated.

☐ Plan of Study: a copy of MyDegree Tracker's Student Educational Plan or an addendum to the	
written statement that outlines a completion plan through graduation on a semester-by-semester	
format that might include summers and/or intersessions.	
☐ Supportive documentation: Submit copies of documents that support the extenuating	
circumstances affecting your academic performance. For instance, if you cite "mental health" as the	
reason for struggling in classes, provide medical documentation. *	
*Mental health claims are serious and require evidence of treatment. Some people use "mental health" to justify negative	
behaviors or poor decisions, which can be a form of psychological avoidance (Balaisis, 2023). If this applies to you,	
acknowledge it in your appeal (but don't casually call it "mental health"). Rather, take responsibility for your actions, and	
explain how you plan to overcome these challenges in the future. There's no shame on owning up to poor decision making, lack	
of motivation, depressive state (with or without treatment), a dislike of college, or whatever the reason might be that might not	
be related to or caused by clinically diagnosed "mental health." However, if you claim "mental health" but did not get treatment, please address why you did not or have not received treatment for this mental illness.
