Additionally, a group of researchers of whom wrote „Individual and Institutional Responses to the Drought: The Case of California Agriculture” made the bold assertion that „governments often respond to drought through crisis management rather than preplanned programs” (Zilberman et al, 17). This report also indicates that the personal detriment outweighs the ecological loss in terms of acting environmentally profitable in practices. As asserted by the authors, „reduction in water supply and increased water prices will lead farmers to [...] adopt water-conserving technology, reduce water use per acre, move away from water-intensive crops, and fallow land” (Zilberman et al, 18). The lack of ecologically friendly maneuvers in water conservation has had negative impacts on multiple levels of the states environmental spectrum.

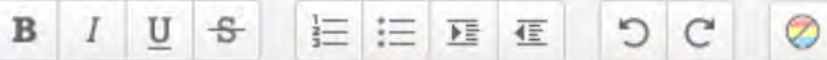
