Vista La Verne Residence Hall

How to Apply

Step 1: Log into MyLaVerne. Click on "Student Services and Financial Aid" to access the Housing Application.

Step 2: Complete Application. Select the application period; complete background information; indicate building/room type preferences; electronically sign the Housing License Agreement; select meal plan; and answer lifestyle/roommate questionnaires. This is a non-refundable fee. Your housing application is active AFTER the fee is paid and application is complete. The application/activity fee is **\$300 for new students.**

Step 4: Room Assignment. Students completing application by May 1, 2019 (Priority Date) will eligible for "Room Assignment" the first two weeks of June. Application and fees received AFTER May 1, 2019 (Priority Date) will be offered space based on availability and on a first come first served basis.

Please note – Applying by priority date does not guarantee a room, as room assignment is based on space availability. To ensure a space, students should apply as early as possible.

Room and roommate assignments are done based on the profile submitted on the application and date of applications. The student will be notified by email (La Verne address) once he/she/they has/have been assigned a housing space. Student can also log on to the housing application to review the assignment.
