Vista La Verne Residence Hall

Vista La Verne is a contemporary residence hall ideal for students wanting more independent and private living. Vista is composed of six-person suite-style units. Two double occupancy rooms and two single occupancy rooms, each with their own restroom. All units include a central lounge, wireless and landline Internet access, and a flat screen TV.

Oaks Residence Hall

The Oaks is ideal for students interested in making friends and developing a strong sense of community! This set of halls boasts small and quaint community environments where working together and getting to know each other is the norm. Each floor consists of a kitchenette and lounge with a flat screen TV.

Citrus Residence Hall

Citrus Hall is located in the heart of campus to sustain a student-centered community. There is a natural connection that embraces the activity and energy happening inside and outside the building. The building is a traditional residential hall with mostly double and triple space options, three lounges, and two study rooms on each floor. Citrus Hall houses mainly first-year students with limited options for continuing students.



How to Apply

Step 1: Log into MyLaVerne. Click on "Student Services and Financial Aid" to access the Housing Application.

Step 2: Complete Application/Pay Application Fee. Select the application period; complete background information; indicate building/room type preferences; electronically sign the Housing License Agreement; select meal plan; and answer lifestyle/roommate questionnaires. The application/activity fees is \$200 and is a non-refundable. Your housing application is active AFTER the fee is paid and application is complete.

Step 3: Room Selection. Students completing the steps outlined above by Friday, March 13, 2020 (priority date) will be eligible to participate in "Room Selection" week. Please note – Applying by priority date does not guarantee a room, as room selection is based on space availability. To ensure a space, students should apply as early as possible.

Applications and fees received AFTER Friday, March 13, 2020 (priority date) will be offered assignment based on availability, distance, and date of when application completed. The student will be notified by email once he/she/they has/have been assigned a housing space. Student can also log on to the housing application to review the assignment.

March 23-27: Room selection week for continuing residents who completed application by March 13th
