Citrus Residence Hall

Citrus Hall is located in the heart of campus to sustain a student-centered community. There is a natural connection that embraces the activity and energy happening inside and outside the building. The building is a traditional style residence hall with primarily double and triple space options, three lounges, and two study rooms on each floor. Citrus Hall houses first-year students, with a limited option for continuing students. This is the perfect place to meet new people and build community.

Oaks Residence Hall

The Oaks is ideal for students interested in making friends and developing a strong sense of community! This set of halls boasts small and quaint community environments where working together and getting to know each other is the norm. Each floor consists of a kitchenette and lounge with a flat screen TV. This hall serves as overflow space for first-year students.



How to Apply

Step 1: Log into MyLaVerne. Click on "Student Services and Financial Aid" to access the Housing Application.

Step 2: Complete Application. Select the application period; complete background information; indicate building/room type preferences; electronically sign the Housing License Agreement; select meal plan; and answer lifestyle/roommate questionnaires. The application/activity fee is **\$200 and non-refundable**. Your housing application is active **AFTER** the fee is paid and application is complete.

Step 4: Room Assignment. Students completing application by May 5, 2020 (Priority Date) will be eligible for "Room Assignment" the first two weeks of June. Application and fees received **AFTER** May 5, 2020 (Priority Date) will be offered space based on availability and on a first come first served basis. Please note – Applying by priority date does not guarantee a room, as room assignment is based on space availability. To ensure a space, students should apply as early as possible.

Room and roommate assignments are done based on payment date and the profile submitted on the application. **The student will be notified by email (La Verne address) once he/she/they has/have been assigned a housing space. Student can also log on to the housing application to review the assignment.**

May 5: Priority Date

June 1-12: New student "Room Placement" weeks; Receive a notification of placement by June 12th

July 20: Deadline to enroll in classes and fulfill financial arrangement with the Student Accounts Office

August 21: New International Student early move-in

August 26: New Student Move-in

August 26: Last day to cancel confirmed License Agreement to receive 100% refund
