# How to Apply

**Step 1: Log into MyLaVerne**. Click on "Student Services and Financial Aid" to access the Housing Application. \*\*\*Law students should first contact housing@laverne.edu for initial instructions when applying.

**Step 2: Complete Application/Pay Application Fee.** Select the application period; complete background information; indicate building/room type preferences; electronically sign the Housing License Agreement; select meal plan; and answer lifestyle/roommate questionnaires. The application/activity fee is **\$200 and non-refundable**. Your housing application is active AFTER the fee is paid and application is complete.

**Step 3: Room Assignment/Selection. New students** completing application by May 5, 2020 (Priority Date) will be eligible for "Room Assignment" during the first two weeks of June. Application and fees received AFTER May 5, 2020 (Priority Date) will be offered space based on availability and on a first come first served basis. **Continuing students** completing application before March 13, 2020 (Priority date) will be eligible for Room Selection during the last week of March (dates below).

Please note – Applying by priority date does not guarantee a room, as room assignment is based on space availability. To ensure a space, students should apply as early as possible.

The student will be notified by email (La Verne address) once he/she/they has/have been assigned a housing space.
