## Vista La Verne Residence Hall

Vista La Verne is a contemporary residence hall ideal for students wanting more independent and private living. Vista is composed of six-person suite-style units. Two double occupancy rooms and two single occupancy rooms, each with their own restroom. All units include a central lounge, wireless and landline Internet access, and a flat screen TV.



# How to Apply

**Step 1: Log into MyLaVerne.** Click on "Student Services and Financial Aid" to access the Housing Application.

**Step 2: Complete Application/Pay Application Fee.** Select the application period; complete background information; indicate building/room type preferences; electronically sign the Housing License Agreement; select meal plan; and answer lifestyle/roommate questionnaires. **The application/activity fees is \$200 and non-refundable. Your housing application is active AFTER the fee is paid and application is complete.**

**Step 3: Room Assignment/Selection.** **New students** completing application by May 5, 2020 (Priority Date) will be eligible for "Room Assignment" during the first two weeks of June. Application and fees received AFTER May 5, 2020 (Priority Date) will be offered space based on availability and on a first come first served basis. **Continuing students** completing application before March 13, 2020 (Priority date) will be eligible for Room Selection during the last week of March (dates below).

Please note – Applying by priority date does not guarantee a room, as room assignment is based on space availability. To ensure a space, students should apply as early as possible.

**The student will be notified by email (La Verne email address) once he/she/they has/have been assigned a housing space.**

## Important Dates for New Students

- February 3:** Online Application Period opens
- May 5:** Priority date for New Students
- June 1-12:** New student "Room Placement" weeks; Receive a notification by June 12th
- July 20:** Deadline for new students to enroll in classes and fulfill financial arrangement with Student Accounts Office
- August 21:** New International Student Move-In
- August 26:** New Student Move-in

## Important Dates for Continuing Students

- February 3:** Online Application Period opens
- March 13:** Priority Date for Continuing Students
- March 18:** "Room Selection Time" notification sent to students
- March 23-27:** Room selection week for continuing residents who completed application by March 13th
- July 20:** Deadline for continuing students to enroll in classes and fulfill financial arrangement with Student Accounts Office
- August 29:** Continuing Student Move-in
