** Transition Days are specific days where students currently residing in res halls will be asked to transition into their summer/fall rooms.

Summer Housing Eligibility Criteria

In order to be eligible to live in the residence halls over the summer, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Have been enrolled as a full-time student in Spring 2026, be enrolled in summer classes in Summer 2026, **or** be enrolled as a full-time student for Fall 2026
- Be in good financial standing with the University
- Be in good judicial standing with the University

Summer Housing Additional Information

- Students will be placed in Vista La Verne Residence Hall for summer housing. Housing will determine specific spaces at the point of room selection/placement.
- There is no meal plan requirement for the summer 2026.
- Students who are living in the halls during the spring 2026 semester/term will be allowed to remain in their current halls until the Spring-to-Summer Transition Day – June 5th. These students should plan to move/transition into their Vista summer room on this date. All other expectations regarding move out apply to these students.
- Students who will be living in housing for fall 2026 will transition to their academic year locations on July 31st. These students should plan to move/transition into their fall room spaces on this date.

- Students who will NOT be living in housing for fall 2026 will need to move out by Friday, July 31st.
- More information/instruction will be sent out closer to move-out dates or transition periods.

How to Apply:

1. Log into La Verne Portal. Under Student Resources, click on “Housing” tab. Then click on “Student Services and Financial Aid, then “Apply for Housing.”
2. Once in the housing application page, follow directions on how to complete “electronic housing application.” Applicants should note that electronic housing application consists of THREE STEPS:

STEP 1 - Consists of a) selecting application period; b) completing background information; c) indicating housing preferences d) answering lifestyle/roommate questions and, e) electronically signing terms and conditions (i.e. contract).

STEP 2 – Paying \$25.00 nonrefundable application fee

STEP 3 – Consists of student being assigned a room. Once complete, a student will be tentatively placed for the summer. Spaces are assigned based on availability.

Students should remember **placements are tentative** until a student has made financial arrangements. Students who do not make arrangements by TBD may lose their housing space and be moved to pending status.
