Diversity Course Offerings Across the Curriculum

Purpose

The Purpose of this report is to present the results of an effort to identify courses with significant diversity coverage across the curriculum in the three college, CAS, CBPM and CEOL.

Method and Procedure

The deans of the colleges were asked in the fall of 2010 to identify courses taught in their colleges with significant diversity coverage. Diversity coverage in a course was defined narrowly as follows:

The course explicitly explores, examines, and/or applies theory to issues related to religious, racial, national, or cultural groups in the context of the United States, and/or within the international context, through the content of lectures, discussions, assignments, personal explorations and reflections, projects, examinations or other learning activities.

This language was agreed to as a working definition by the faculty of the Assessment Subcommittee of the Educational Effectiveness Committee after consultation of a number of sources including the WASC Policies Manual (2009), La Verne's Diversity Strategic Plan, and La Verne's General Education definition of learning outcomes in "Community and Diversity."

The deans were provided with an Excel file with courses listed in the Banner System under their college. For CAS and CBPM the courses listed for the 2009-2010 academic year were used. For CEOL the courses listed for the 2008-2009 academic year were used, since this was the list they were using in their preparation for the NCATE accreditation visit planned for February of 2011.

CAS decided to use the list of courses approved to meet the General Education requirement for "Community and Diversity." Most probably this tended to underestimate the courses with diversity coverage, since there may be courses that address diversity but have not applied for or have not been approved to meet the GE outcome-based set of requirement with accompanying assessment strategies.

CEOL included courses that met the working definition above and as well as the NCATE diversity requirements.

Summary of Findings

The appendices A, B, and C present the complete list of Banner courses with notations that identify diversity courses in CAS, CBPM, and CEOL, respectively.

Table 1 below summarizes the findings across three colleges. It includes total number of courses offered in the college as well as the number and percentage of diversity courses at

the graduate and undergraduate levels. Overall, 10.2% of the courses offered at La Verne’s three colleges, CAS, CBPM and CEOL, have been reported to have coverage of diversity issues narrowly defined in terms of religious, racial, national, or cultural groups in the US and/or the international context.

The 6.4% of CAS courses with diversity coverage may be somewhat of an underestimation. The college chose to report only GE approved course that meet “Community and Diversity” learning outcome at the undergraduate level. There may be other courses with such coverage that may not have been submitted for GE inclusion. The Graduate level includes psychology course at the Master’s and Doctoral levels with explicit diversity coverage as noted in their titles, even though coverage of diversity issues is quite pervasive across courses.

The 9.8% of CBPM courses with diversity coverage as defined include significant coverage in the international context. Closer inspection of course may yield more diversity courses, especially the ones dealing with organizational behavior and communication.

The 41.7% of CEOL courses with diversity coverage is impressively high, with 60% at the undergraduate level. The college is currently seeking NCATE accreditation. This list partially reflects the NCATE accreditation criterion of diversity coverage in the curriculum, as well as the CTC requirements in credential programs.

The next steps would involve spot-checking a random sample of course syllabi to verify the extent of diversity coverage in these courses, as well as inspect the curriculum maps reported in program reviews.
