

Psychology Undergraduate Program Assessment Plan

The goal of the assessment plan of the Psychology Undergraduate Program is to provide faculty with on-going and meaningful information to help improve learning outcomes. The following assessment procedures are used:

1. **Senior Exit Survey**
 - Students in the Senior Thesis Seminar complete the Senior Exit Survey every semester
2. **Comprehensive Exit Exam**
 - Students take the Comprehensive Exit Exam during the Senior Thesis Seminar
3. **Evaluation of Senior Theses**
 - Instructors evaluate each Senior Thesis using a common rubric
4. **Evaluation of internships**
 - On-site internship supervisors evaluate student performance using a common evaluation form
5. **Alumni Survey**
 - Alumni are surveyed every five years
6. **Syllabus Analysis**
 - Faculty conduct syllabus analysis every five years using program goals as criteria
