Psychology Undergraduate Program Assessment Plan

The goal of the assessment plan of the Psychology Undergraduate Program is to provide faculty with on-going and meaningful information to help improve learning outcomes. The following assessment procedures are used:

1. Senior Exit Survey

• Students in the Senior Thesis Seminar complete the Senior Exit Survey every semester

2. Comprehensive Exit Exam

• Students take the Comprehensive Exit Exam during the Senior Thesis Seminar

3. Evaluation of Senior Theses

• Instructors evaluate each Senior Thesis using a common rubric

4. Evaluation of internships

• On-site internship supervisors evaluate student performance using a common evaluation form

5. Alumni Survey

• Alumni are surveyed every five years

6. Syllabus Analysis

• Faculty conduct syllabus analysis every five years using program goals as criteria
