Assessment Plan 2005

The goal of the assessment plan of the Department of Art and Art History is to provide faculty with on-going and meaningful information to help improve learning outcomes. The following assessment procedures are used:

1. Assessment of student class work

Student work is assessed on an on-going basis using rubrics for grading purposes and for program reviews

2. Senior projects

Judges evaluate senior projects using rubrics at the end of every semester every semester

3. Senior exit survey

Seniors are surveyed at the end every semester to obtain their assessment of learning outcomes, and satisfaction with different aspects of the program

4. Alumni Survey

Alumni of the program are surveyed every 5 years

5. SWOT interviews

Students and other stakeholders are periodically interview, individually or in focus groups, to evaluate the strengths, weaknesses and opportunities of the program
