- Recognizes some factors but fails to identify the complexity of factors involved.
- Makes general recommendations for solutions that are not multifaceted or interdisciplinary.

<u>Poor - 1</u>

- Identifies only one disciplinary perspective.
- Identifies the contribution of only one discipline in dealing with the issue.
- Recognizes primarily one factor involved in dealing with the issue.
- Makes vague recommendations for solutions that are not multifaceted or interdisciplinary.
