The goal of the assessment plan of the Sociology/Criminology program is to provide faculty with on-going and meaningful information to help improve learning outcomes. The following assessment procedures are used:

1. Senior Exit Survey

- Students in the Senior Project classes complete the senior exit survey every semester

2. Alumni Survey

- Alumni Complete an alumni survey every five years

3. Analysis of Course Syllabi

- Faculty review course syllabi to assess their currency and content to ensure they address program goals

4. Internship

- Internship courses are evaluated to determine learning outcomes

5. Performance measure

- A performance measure will be developed to address learning outcomes specified in program goals
