

Certificate of Clearance Process

The Certificate of Clearance (COC) is issued by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC) using a direct web application. In order to apply, you must have your fingerprints live scanned. The COC is valid for 5 years once it's issued.

- The application fee is \$52.50 paid online directly to CCTC.
- There is **an additional fee** for the live scan fingerprinting paid to the live scan operator you choose.
- You must pay both fees to complete the process.

Carefully follow these steps to apply:

- 1. Complete the Request for Live Scan Service form.
 - a. Form 41-LS: http://www.ctc.ca.gov/credentials/leaflets/41-LS.pdf
 - b. You can type on the form. Fill in Section 3 and Section 4.
 - c. Print three copies of the Live Scan 41-LS form.
- 2. Take these copies to a location offering Live Scan electronic fingerprint services for submission to the Live Scan operator.
 - a. Go to this website to search for a Live Scan location near you. https://oag.ca.gov/fingerprints/locations
 - b. After being live scanned, retain a copy of the Live Scan form for your records.
- 3. Watch this short 3-minute video of how to submit your online certificate of clearance.

- 4. Follow the directions in the video/written instructions.
- 5. Once you receive your payment confirmation page online, you may scan/email that page to your advisor as proof that you've completed this process. Or, you can email your advisor to inform him/her.
- Fingerprint clearance with CCTC is required in order to qualify for a credential. We need to confirm your fingerprint clearance before you begin field experience.
- CCTC's background check is completed by both the DOJ and FBI.
- If you think you already have fingerprint clearance with CCTC, please do a <u>Secured Search</u> on CCTC's website. Contact your academic advisor to ask if you have a valid document for your program. FYI: School district fingerprinting as a classified employee is usually not shared with CCTC.
- In most cases, CCTC will issue the Certificate of Clearance online within 10 working days.
- In some cases, an additional evaluation is required based upon responses to the professional fitness questions. It's important to respond honestly to these questions.
