All registration holds from the university must be cleared.

Placement Policies

- EDUC 497, & EDUC 497B are full-day supervised teaching experiences conducted over a five-week period.
- SPED 409 requires full-day supervised teaching experiences conducted over a ten-week period.
- Placement for Traditional Student Teaching is assigned based on the district, schoolsite, School-Site Supervisor, grade, and subject where the majority of Early and Pre-

Clinical Teaching was completed, as long as the placement meets the credential being earned.

- Placement for Intern Teaching must be at a pre-approved district with whom we have an MOU.
- Illness or approved exceptions are the only excuse for not being at your assigned classroom for the entire Clinical Teaching experience. You are not permitted to take any day off from Clinical Teaching to complete Cycle 1 TPA assignments.
- Being removed from a fieldwork or student teaching placement by a district, site, or a supervisor, is a serious concern that is addressed on a case-by-case basis. A student study team of multiple faculty members will meet to hear concerns and come to a consensus on next steps. If it is determined the student was removed for a serious offense, they will not be allowed to continue in the credential program. The team can also determine that the student will receive a new placement in order to demonstrate they have grown in the areas of concern. If the student is removed from the second placement, there will not be a third placement. The student will not be allowed to continue in the program.
- Please do not make arrangements with your company for leave until you have received a confirmed placement from the Clinical Teaching office.
- All confirmed district, school, and grade level placements will be final and no changes will be made.
- The Office of Clinical Teaching and Fieldwork Experience is responsible for placement communications. Please do not contact the school or district for placement unless directed to do so.
- Further policies are provided in the SPED 409, EDUC 497 and EDUC 497B syllabi.


