## • Field Experience

- Fifteen hours of field experience is required for each of these courses: EDUC 425, EDUC 426, EDUC 440, and EDUC 441. Ten hours of field experience is required for EDUC 491 and EDUC 492. (80 hours total)
- Each course requires the field experience to focus on a specific area, such as teaching English learners or the teaching of reading.

### • Clinical Teaching

- o EDUC 497 requires 5 weeks of student teaching (all day, five days a week.)
- o EDUC 498 requires 10 weeks of student teaching (all day, five days a week.)
