- **Field Experience**
 - Fifteen hours of field experience is required for each of these courses: EDUC 427, EDUC 428, EDUC 442, and EDUC 443. Ten hours of field experience is required for EDUC 494 and EDUC 495. (80 hours total)
 - Each course requires the field experience to focus on a specific area, such as teaching English learners or the teaching of reading.
- **Clinical Teaching**
 - EDUC 497 requires 5 weeks of student teaching (all day, five days a week.)
 - EDUC 498 requires 10 weeks of student teaching (all day, five days a week.)
