Hybrid Courses

Hybrid courses will meet in person for three hours per week in class and two hours online via Blackboard or will arrange 6 or 7 classes on ground with the remaining online. Meeting dates to be determined by instructor.

Telepresence™ (video conferencing) Courses

Telepresence classes are taught in the classroom. The faculty member teaches the same course to two or three groups of students located in different geographic locations. Telepresence™ allows students in different locations to engage with each other at the same time through interactive video conferencing. Students are expected to attend each class session, as they would a regular face-to-face class. Additionally, student participation and assignments are the same as the regular face-to-face classes.
