<u>UNDERGRADUATE</u> SPECIAL COURSE INSTRUCTIONS

*CS 305: In addition to the discussions and written assignments, students are required to complete a minimum of 20 hours of community service. It is recommended that students complete CS 305 at least two terms prior to their anticipated graduation date.
*HUM 313 (Dr. Clark): Requires independent fieldtrips to 6 museums and 4 plays. No text book is required for this course.

HUM 313 Attendance Policy: In keeping with the "Class Attendance" policy contained in the University's catalog, students who do not submit the first week's assignment by midnight of Sunday, September 29, will be administratively dropped from HUM 313 online by Tuesday, October 1st. This assignment, a report on a museum visit or on attendance at an approved performance of drama, dance, music, or opera, is due at midnight on Sunday of the first week of classes (September 29), and the last day to drop (or be administratively dropped) from Fall 2019 Term courses with a 100% refund is Tuesday, October 1, 2019.

***MATH 102:** Requires an online proctoring fee of up to \$14 per exam. There are 4 tests in a term.
