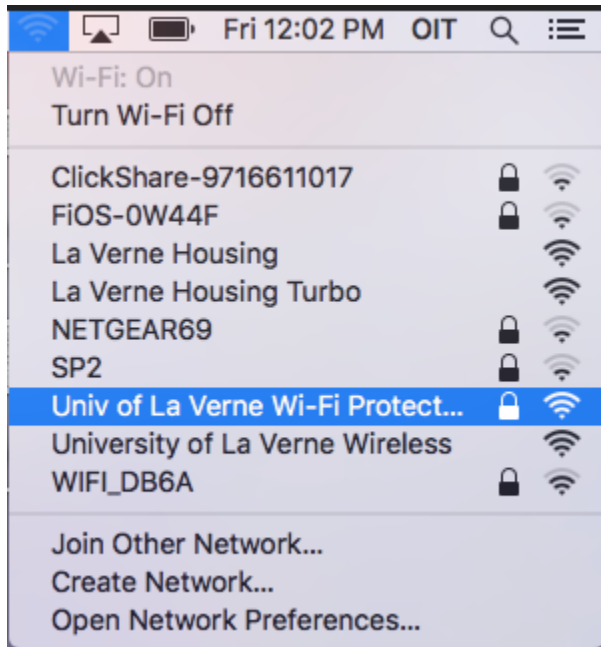


Mac OS

Instructions on how to connect to the “**Univ of La Verne Wi-Fi Protected**” Wi-Fi network with your Mac OS device for the first time.


**Step 1:** Select “**Univ of La Verne Wi-Fi Protected**” from the Airport Menu.



**Step 2:** Enter your University of La Verne **e-mail** credentials and click **Join**.

Optional Step: you can check the **“Remember this network”** box if you want your device to remember this Wi-Fi network.



Verify Certificate

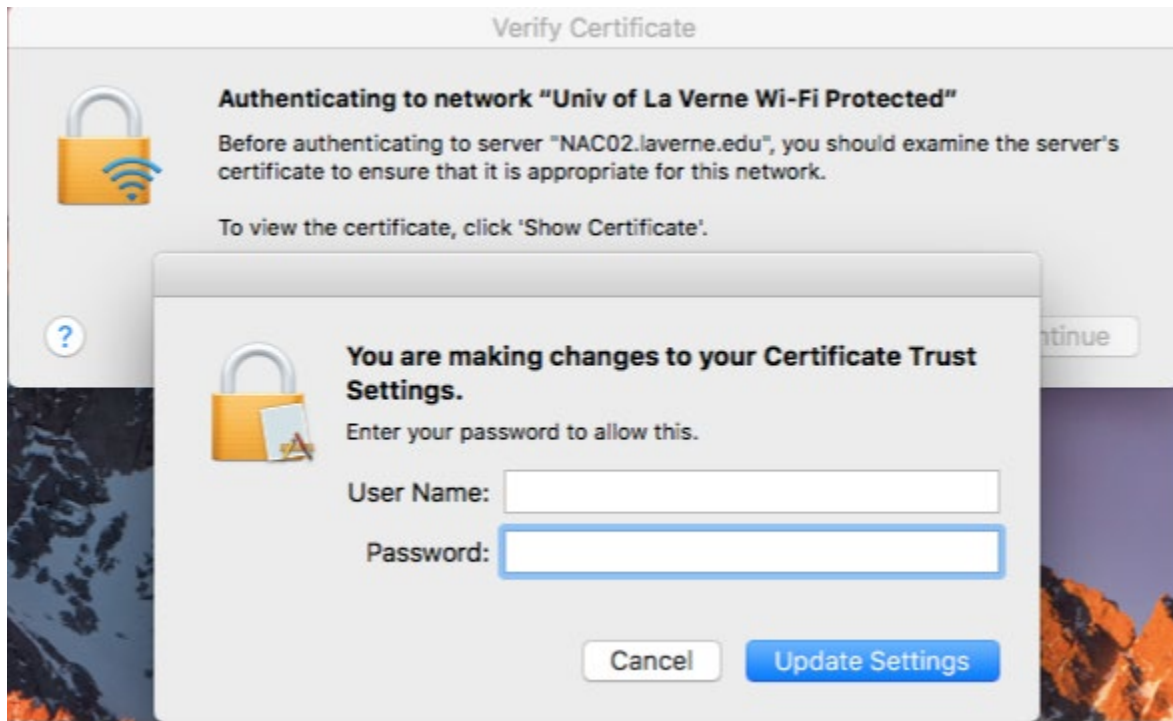
Authenticating to network "Univ of La Verne Wi-Fi Protected"

**Step 4:** Enter your **Mac admin username and password** to save it to your certificate chain and then click **Update Settings**



**Step 5:** You are now **connected**, to confirm click on the Wi-Fi icon on the Airport Menu
