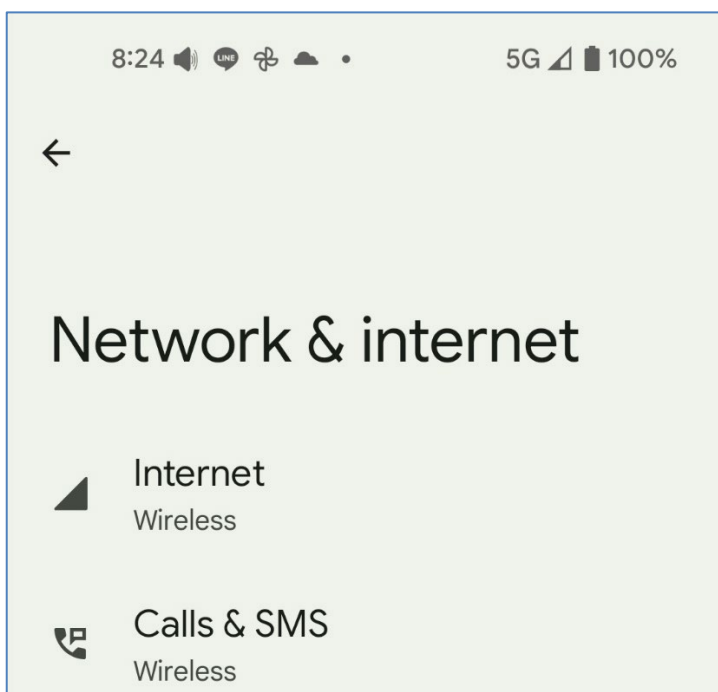
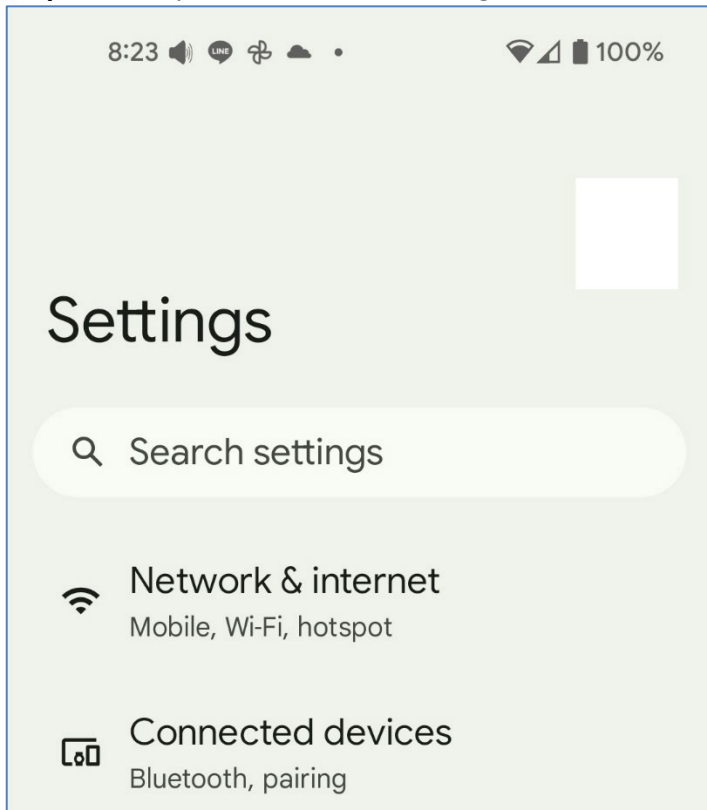


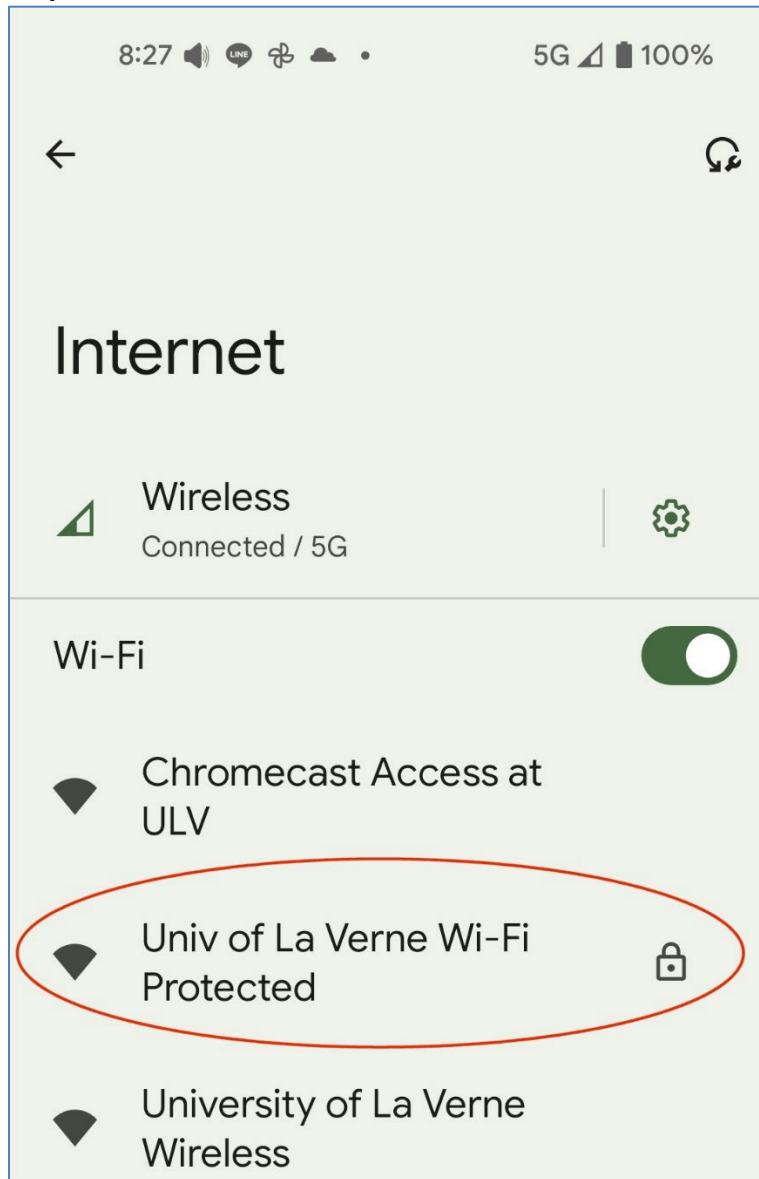
Android OS

Follow these steps to connect your Android device to the “Univ of La Verne Wi-Fi Protected” network for the first time.

Step 1: Go to your device’s **Wi-Fi settings**.



Step 2: Select “Univ of La Verne Wi-Fi Protected” from the list of available networks.



Step 3: Make sure EAP method is set to **PEAP** and Phase 2 authentication is set to **MSCHAPV2**.

Select the **CA certificate** drop-down menu and select “**Use System Certificates**”.

Step 4: Leave the **Online Certificate Status** with “**Do not verify**” and enter **laverne.edu** in the **Domain** field.

Then, enter your University of La Verne **email** credentials:

- **Identity:**

- If your **username is 20 characters or fewer**, enter just your username (example: john.smith)
- If your **username is longer than 20 characters**, enter your **full email address** (example: alexandra.jones-smith@laverne.edu)

- **Password:** Your University of La Verne email password.

Tap **Connect** to finish.
